

# WHEEL CLEANING CHECKLIST

Wheel cleaning is most efficient when done as part of your normal wash process, during the “pre-soak” step while foam is still dwelling. For tips on cleaning matte and metal wheels, reference our full guide.

## STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

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| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>1. PREP &amp; PRE-RINSE</b><br>Blast the wheel (JET or 40° tip) to shed loose grime.      | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>5. CALIPERS &amp; BEHIND SPOKES</b><br>Use a small brush to clean calipers & flexible brush to clean behind spokes. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>2. SPRAY CLEANER</b><br>Apply to barrel first, then face and work bottom-up.              | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>6. FACE, LUG NUTS, SPOKES</b><br>Use a soft wheel brush (or microfiber towel for gloss) to clean all face features. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>3. LET DWELL</b><br>Allow cleaner to sit for 30-45 seconds maximum. Do not let dry.       | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>7. RINSE THOROUGHLY</b><br>Rinse the wheel fully. Be sure to remove all soap from hard-to-reach areas.              |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>4. AGITATE SUDS ON BARREL</b><br>Use a flexible wheel brush to agitate inside the barrel. | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>8. DRY &amp; REPEAT</b><br>Rinse the wheel fully. Be sure to remove all soap from hard-to-reach areas.              |
